Mentors are adults in the school building, such as teachers, school leaders, librarians, or other instructors. Mentors commit to providing personalized support and getting to know the students as whole people: academically, socially and emotionally.

The weekly check-in and any other organic mentor support revolve around ensuring that a student's daily actions and current progress are aligned to his or her individual long term goals and aspirations.
